

Capacity building workshop directed to CSOs and Government institutions “training on tools and technic of communications and leadership” May 2018”

After analyzing the process of Reinsertion and Reintegration of the ex-combatant of Boko initiated by the Government of Niger since December 2016. COPAVE found the necessary to go and learn and to gain experience in this domain which is unknown in Niger. For that reason we made our first activity with the support of Global Center in Jun 2017. The activity was a study of the process of reconciliation and disarmament and demobilization in Cote D'Ivoire. Why Cote d'Ivoire? We preferred to have the experience of Cote D'Ivoire because it was one of the first West African county that successfully completed a reconciliation process. And experiencing the DDR process. In this sense we focused our research on selecting key actors and government institutions which worked in the implementation of the process of reconciliation of Cote d'Ivoire. We then exchanged on the process with active actors from Abidjan, Yamoussoukro and Bouaké because this geographic zone were very impacted by the crises and they have play an important role in huge situation of reconciliation. With the support of a Journalist from Cote D'Ivoire we validated the list of actors in the respect of a criteria of pertinence, key role in the process, level of influence in the community ... etc. We then submit our questionnaire to: The politicians in both side (opposition party and regime on power), traditional leaders, religious leaders, Civil Society leaders, youth, ECOWAS Community members based in Côte D'Ivoire and institutions in charge of the reconciliation and also economic operators and Artists. From this important and successful interviews and focus groups discussions with 20 organization and institutions. We were able to gather technics and tools and approach that strengthen our knowledge in the domain of Reconciliation and had good view of the DDR program. The interviewed personalities were very interesting and they found our initiative very salutary. So they really provide us with the maximum of information, guidance, tools and technics. That was our first line of demarcation in the process of reconciliation and we were ready to make some changes once we are back in Niger. We then contextualize the approach of Cote d'Ivoire in the Context of Niger in our report. And we prepared to share the tools with our Nigerian fellow engage in the process. We then share the first report with some Organization and Government Institution.

With the strengthening of the capacities of the staff of COPAVE in the domain of Reintegration and Reinsertion of ex-combatant. COPAVE moved at the next step. Share the experience with Nigerian CSOs and Government Institutions. In this sense a follow up activity was implemented in February 2015. That activity gather 29 representatives of CSOs form Diffa and Niamey and the representatives of Government Institutions. Via participative method we shared the result of the research of Cote d'Ivoire. During that exercise the participant discovered the tools that the actors of Cote d'Ivoire used to successfully address the process of reconciliation. They were able to appreciate the level of motivation and the commitment of the actors in Cote d'Ivoire and also the importance of the interaction and complementary of actors. We were able to compare the context of Cote d'Ivoire and the context of Niger and we end up with the conclusion that even if the context are different, the problem remain the same. Human being exploitation in conflict situation. After that we pursued with the next exercise which is the adaptation in the context of Niger. The Participant were all happy to see that they could contribute to the implementation on the process of reinsertion of the ex-combatant of boko haram. Unfortunately the CSOs and the Government doesn't have the requested tools and approach to go through the process. For that reason, COPAVE initiated one additional activity. The Capacity building of CSOs and Government Institutions.

May 2018, we implemented our activity of the Capacity Building of CSOs and Government Institutions with 20 participants form CSOs and Government Institution. The activity provided them with the necessary tools and technics of diagnostics, analyses and addressing the problem of Reintegration of the repent of Boko
